The proposal should not exceed two pages. It should be formatted according to the <u>Paper Formatting guidelines</u> and include:

- Topic
- Challenges to be discussed
- Panelist candidates (6-8 people) and Moderator/Chair candidate(s)
- Preparation Milestones
- Description of the panel execution (e.g. form, style, timing, moderation)
- Expected outcome (e.g. discussion, interaction, summary paper, agenda, repository of ideas)

Workshop and Tutorial Proposal Guidelines

The proposal should not exceed 2 pages. It should be formatted according to the Paper Formatting guidelines and include:

- Workshop/Tutorial title
- Abstract (max 250 words)
- Topic
- Organizers (and their affiliation)
- Proposed Program Committee
- Planned review procedures
- Expected sponsorships
- Profile of a typical attendee (e.g. academic researcher, student or industry participant)
- Rough estimate of the number of participants
- Duration (e.g. 1 session, 2 sessions or 4 sessions)
- In case the workshop/tutorial has been previously held, provide information on the conference date, and number of attendees
- In case of Workshop, what the intended format will be (e.g. intended presentations, submitted presentations, panels, etc.)
- In case of Tutorial, an extended description of 10-12 pages is also welcome. It will be submitted as a Regular paper and will go through the same review procedures by the SummerSim Program Committee. Regular paper submission deadline applies.
